**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S EX PARTE APPLICATION TO APPROVE PROPOSED ADDENDUM TO ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION OF PLAINTIFF FOR APPOINTMENT OF RECEIVER TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO POTENTIALLY INTERESTED PARTIES**

Based on the ex parte application by the Receiver Douglas Wilson (the "Receiver") for an order regarding the provision of notice to potentially-interested parties of the receivership and activities of the Receiver, and having held a hearing on June 23, 2021 on the Receiver's ex parte application, at which all potentially interested parties in attendance were given the opportunity to be heard regarding the content of such an order, the Court ORDERS as follows:


1. Not later than seven (7) days after the entry of this Order, the Receiver will send a letter, via first class postage pre-paid United States mail, to all individuals and entities

1 the Receiver has, through the exercise of reasonable diligence, identified as potentially  
2 interested parties – including, without limitation, those identified in the Receiver’s  
3 June 17, 2021 Ex Parte Application to Approve Proposed Addendum (ROA #84) as  
4 customers and clients, County Recorder’s Offices, vendors and potential creditors, and  
5 landlords or property managers for leased office spaces. The letter will (a) notify the  
6 potentially-interested parties of the pendency of this lawsuit and of the appointment of  
7 the Receiver; (b) attach a copy of the Court’s June 9, 2021 Order Granting Ex Parte  
8 Application of Plaintiff for Appointment of Receiver (the “Order Appointing  
9 Receiver”); (c) advise potentially-interested parties specifically how they may request  
10 to receive notice of receivership activity (as provided in the Order Appointing  
11 Receiver); and (d) advise potentially-interested parties how they may obtain  
12 information via the Receiver’s website regarding the Receiver’s activities and the  
13 status of the Receivership.

- 14 2. To the extent the Receiver later learns of additional potentially-interested parties, he  
15 shall provide the newly-identified potentially-interested parties with the same letter as  
16 soon as practicable after learning of their identity.
- 17 3. The Receiver shall maintain, and regularly update, a website to which he shall post  
18 timely updates of information regarding the status of actions taken by the Receiver,  
19 which shall include (without limitation) (a) a copy of all documents filed by the  
20 Receiver in this action; (b) a copy of all orders entered by the Court relating to the  
21 Receivership.
- 22 4. Counsel for the Receiver is ordered to give notice of this Order.
